

TED KENNEDY BREAKS GROUND FOR BE&K GOVERNMENT GROUP

During a groundbreaking ceremony held March 16th, 2007 on Construction Battalion Center Gulfport, Mississippi BE&K Government Group, Inc. along with Roy Anderson Corp. and TJC Engineering were recognized by the facility commander CAPT Van Dobson as key partners in the rebuilding efforts on the base. BE&K Government Group is one three contractors currently starting construction projects on CBC Gulfport as part of the Navy's Katrina Re-Capitalization Program. The Government Group is constructing a \$41.5 million logistics warehouse along with a terminal security gate and inspection station for all logistics transports that will relieve traffic congestion at the other gates. Ted Kennedy, founder of BE&K, Inc. represented the Government Group during the ceremony, was provided a tour of the base, the project areas and met with the members of the BE&K Government Group on site. This project is a significant win for the Government Group and is propelling the company towards additional opportunities in the region.
